What is it?

ArgyleArts in StudioC is a visual arts ministry that will host a fine art gallery of juried visual arts created by artists from the Argyle Church and community. This celebration of art allows visitors to experience a diversity of fine art inspired by God using the gifts and talents that he has given.

How will it work?

Periodically a Topic will be chosen. It may be a subject such as Nature, Love, and Easter etc. Artists will create a piece of work using that topic.

What criteria must my work have?

Each work presented for exhibit consideration must give praise and glory to God.

What medium can my work be in?

You may use whatever medium you are comfortable working with or if you wish to be lead to trying something different. Acceptable mediums are Paint of any type (oil, water color, and acrylic, etc), Charcoal, Pencil, Pastels, Chalk, Ink, Sculpture and 2-D mixed media. We are also looking for Photography and Video.

What about crafts?

Crafts take creativity, talent and a keen eye. However, we are looking for works of art that start from a blank canvas without pre-made materials.

How old do you need to be to participate?

God gives gifts of talent to many people. Some people discover or utilize these talents at a very early age. All pieces will be considered based on merit and age level.

What will happen to the art work?

We will ask that your art work be submitted to us by a specific deadline. Submitted art will be reviewed by a panel of three. After the pieces are critiqued they will be presented to Rick Painter for final approval. Accepted pieces will be placed in the “ArgyleCafé in StudioC” and the “Welcome Center” in a Gallery setting for the enjoyment of others.

What will happen to the art work after that?

Will there be art lessons?

Initially that is not the purpose of the ministry. It is a consideration as things move forward. Guidance will be given at the first critique. Questions will be handled on an individual basis.

Answers to other FAQ's:

-You can submit as many pieces of work as you want. They can be the same or different mediums.

-We can assist you in mating or preparing your work for viewing.

- Your work should give praise and glory to God but does not have to be religious in design.

-If you did not attend the original meeting you are still welcome to bring your work for viewing consideration.

-You do not have to be a member of The Church at Argyle in order to participate. We encourage you to tell your friends and family.

-You do not have to be a professional artist or photographer. If you have a God given talent for any of the visual arts...your work is welcome.

-We will make every effort to keep your work safe from harm. Buildings are locked after Worship Gatherings. We would hope that all those viewing the galleries would respect the artists work as well as the time and love the artist put into their works.

Items and Dates to Remember

First Theme: General

For the first exhibit we will have an open theme. This means that you may chose any subject that you desire. The only factor is that is must give glory and praise to God. It can be nature, a feeling, a special place, etc.

First critique: April 6 at 12:15 pm.

At the first critique any pre-planning or early stages of your project can be brought in for discussion. At this critique you will be offered guidance and confirmation that your work is moving in the right direction.

Final critique and submission of finished work:

April 20 at 12:15 pm.

All finished works will be brought in as described in the Rules, Application and Usage Form.
